When considering applications, we look for residents who will contribute to and gain from our community as a whole. We take into account the written application, interview presentation, referees' reports, academic background and community involvement.

2017 Fees

We understand that a Women's College experience represents a significant investment for any family. We pride ourselves on our ability to offer exceptional accommodation, full catering and service at a fair value.

The annual fee is \$21,177 (2017) which includes;

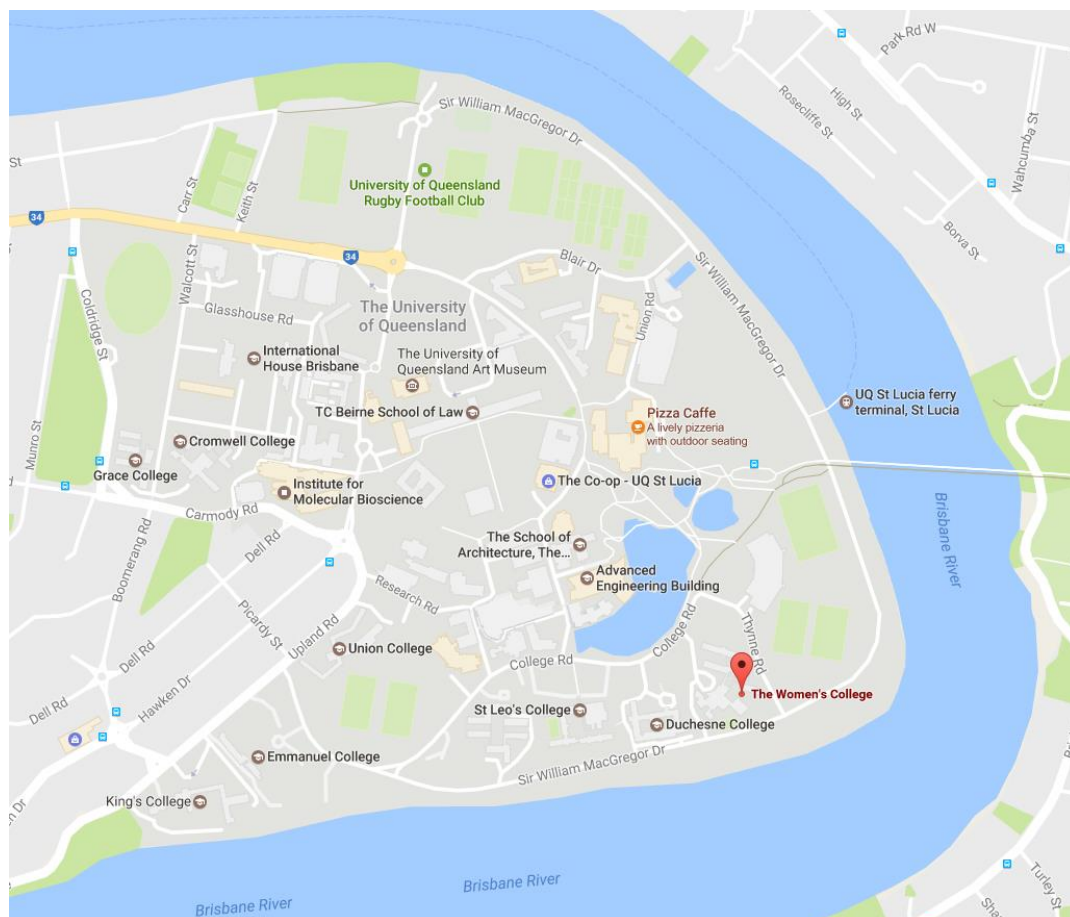

Location



The Women's College is at the start of College Road, which is directly across the lake from UQ.

Within easy walking distance are several facilities including the UQ Lakes bus terminal, St Lucia ferry terminal, UQ gym, swimming pool, tennis courts, cafes and more.

The buses to QUT and Griffith University are frequent and easy to access from the UQ Lakes bus stop just 500 metres from The Women's College.

Application process

Applications must be received by 30 September to be considered for the following year and we appreciate early, thoughtful and complete applications. Steps include:

- Visit The Women's College admission page for a step to step guide for admission www.womens.uq.edu.au/admission
- Once The Women's College receives the completed on line application and supporting documents (Application Fee Form and two Referee Report Forms) we will send you an email asking you to contact us to arrange an interview. Interviews occur throughout the year.
- An offer of residency is based on your demonstrated ability to contribute to and gain from College life. We take into account your written application, interview presentation, referees' reports, academic background and community involvement.
