The Women's College is a women's only fully catered residential facility located on campus at the University of Queensland.

Our 255 residents attend a range of tertiary facilities in Brisbane including: UQ, QUT and Griffith.

Women's College is your home away from home. Here you will live in beautiful surroundings, eat sumptuous food, be inspired by your peers, develop leadership skills in our Ready to Lead program, and make friends for life.

It is a safe, friendly, inclusive environment that enables students to become scholars; nurtures young women into responsible adults; and fosters educated women leaders who are empowered to think big and reach far.



## Ready to learn

Academic support of students is offered through weekly tutorials in specific subjects, facilitating access to programs offered by the University, one-on-one assistance in developing sound study and time management skills, and in a less official capacity, through mentoring from fellow students.

## Ready to live

Each room is private and secure. Attractive and comfortable single bedrooms contain a bed, desk, chair, light, bookshelves, heater and fan, as well as ample storage space.



All rooms have access to the internet through the College Network. All rooms sit within Wings that have their own kitchens, gathering areas and shared bathrooms.

## Ready to care

There are many layers of pastoral care provided within the College, starting with a third year Resident Assistants who live in the corridors with the residents, reception staff until 11pm including weekends and the Head of College and Deputy Head live in College. Further support is provided through the Dean of Learning, Senior Resident Assistant and all College staff.



## Ready to lead

A wide range of guest speakers are invited to regular Formal Dinners to share their expertise, advice and experience with the residents. An annual Professional Networking Dinner enables residents to meet alumnae who are currently working in their chosen study area. There is also a suite of other programs to equip our residents as the next generation of leaders.
