


2024 Exhibitor Information



### Introduction

Presented by The Women's College within The University of Queensland as part of the Ready to Lead program, Women's Industry Night (WIN) is a networking and career building experience that aims to connect industry groups and employers with students. WIN was established in 2022.

The event is a showcase designed to provide students with an opportunity to engage their interests and curiosities, test assumptions, and learn about the world of work. It is a mini-exhibition focused on creating value for all participants by bringing together students, Women's College alumnae, and employers to discuss and explore specific industries.

## Exhibitor information

Women's Industry Night is an opportunity for exhibitors to offer valuable advice to help students kickstart their careers, learn about pathways and gain a deeper understanding about industries.

The showcase provides spaceonly for up to 25 stalls, all the same size (2 m x 2 m), where companies are invited to be as creative as they like. Exhibitors plan what marketing collateral they will bring; for example: a pop up banner, pop-up counter, brochures, showbags, business cards, digital device (laptop or iPad with own power source for the duration of the event).


There is no cost to register or participate as an exhibitor.

#### About the venue


The venue, our Harriet Marks Dining Hall, has space for up to 25 stalls at a 2 m x 2 m size (4 m² space-only); no walls provided. While The Women's College cannot provide each exhibitor with a power source within the Dining Hall due to limited facilities, exhibitors are encouraged to provide their own fully charged digital devices. Canapés and a bar (not pictured in the above floorplan) will be provided to event participants and guests throughout the evening.
