RESIDENCY PERIOD

Residency fees are charged for the full academic year, excluding the semester vacation weeks, commencing at midday on the first Sunday of each semester, and ending at 10:00am on the final Sunday, as follows:

- Semester 1: Sunday 23 February to Sunday 22 June 2025
- Semester 2: Sunday 27 July to Sunday 23 November 2025

Fees are payable for the entire academic year, irrespective of whether students choose to spend days during the semesters away from College.

A. Vacation periods

C. Family discount

The Women's College: Where two sisters live in College simultaneously, a 7.5% discount will be applied to the sister who is a Second or Third Year Resident.

St Leo's College: Where two siblings live at Women's College and St Leo's College simultaneously, a 3.75% discount will be applied to each sibling at both Colleges.

D. International students

All international students pay a full semester's fees in advance on the first instalment date of any semester.

E. Meal and guest charges

Students may bring guests to College and will be charged as outlined in the Student Handbook.
